



My Screen showed the message "Anti-Theft System This system has lost power. Push and hold the power button for more than two seconds to enable the system". Did that a dozen times. Restarted car and drove 10 times. no change. Screen is blank.



Anti-Theft/Nav System Lost Power. My 2015 CRV Touring only has 14000 miles on it and I replaced the battery 2 years ago. The battery has about 4000 miles on it. Today when I started the car I got an alert Anti-Theft System has lost power and I need to hold the power button down for 2 seconds.



Do you experience a Honda CR-V anti theft system lost power problem? Perhaps you have noticed that your Honda CR-V anti theft system is not working anymore. Or, you have been observing some glitches to it lately. If you are going through this ???

HONDA CR V ANTI THEFT SYSTEM LOST POWER



Honda always had an anti-theft code to unlock the car or reenable after losing power and I'm guessing the push button is similar to the radio aspect. So I would have Honda check your power connections for the battery.



If your Honda CR-V's anti-theft system has lost power, you may need to reset it. To do this, first disconnect the battery. Then, touch the positive and negative terminals of the battery together for a few seconds.



The message has the instruction to hold down the volume button for 2 secs. to re-enable the audio system due to a power loss. While this message occurs any time power is lost, there's a bug in the system and it occurs randomly even when there is no power loss.

HONDA CR V ANTI THEFT SYSTEM LOST POWER



It's pretty much an innocuous error and easy to fix, the power button that they are referring to is the audio system power button, the one in the upper left hand corner of the infotainment screen. Press and hold that for a few seconds and the infotainment screen will reboot and the error should go away.
