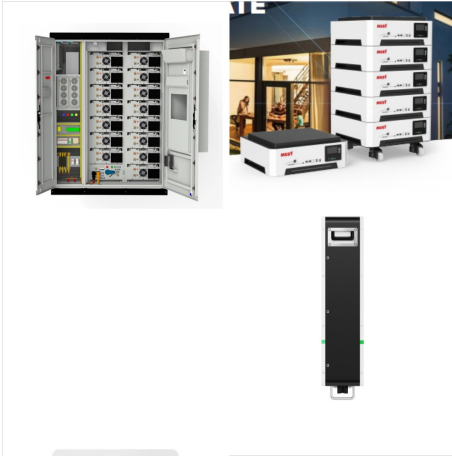

Approximately 250 workers were threatened to lose their jobs in the factory that was founded in 1920. Established as a joint-stock company, the Zoellner family took over all shares in Accumulatorenwerke HOPPECKE in 1936 and now manages the company through Dr. Marc Zoellner in the fourth generation. In 90 years of HOPPECKE a lot has happened.
