

What makes a good UPS battery backup?

Does a UPS battery backup need to power up?

Unlike a backup generator, it does not need to power up in order to start generating power. In other words, if you experience a power outage in your area, your machinery should not shut down if it is plugged into a UPS battery backup.

Can you use a battery backup to power your home?

Instead of paying high electricity rates during peak usage hours, you can use energy from your battery backup to power your home. In off-peak hours, you can use your electricity as normal -- but at a cheaper rate -- and recharge your battery when it costs less.

Do you need a battery backup?

One important part of your plan should be considering battery backups--also known as an uninterruptible power supply, or UPS--which will automatically take over when the power drops or goes out entirely. But no one solution's perfect for everyone.

Why do I need a battery backup?

In order to protect your computer against power supply interruptions, you need a battery backup. UPS units are like power strips that contain a big battery inside, providing a buffer against power supply interruptions. This buffer can range from a few minutes to an hour or more depending on the size of the unit.

An uninterruptible power supply, or battery backup, can help protect your computer. It can provide backup power when the electricity goes out, act as a power "conditioners" to keep electricity flowing to your computer and accessories free from drops or surges, and decrease noisy power sources.



To do this, add up the power consumption of all critical loads that require backup power, and multiply this by the number of hours you need the backup power to last. For example, if your critical loads require 2,000 watts of power and you need backup power for 24 hours, your total load would be 48,000 watt-hours (2,000 watts x 24 hours).
