

We highly recommend hiring a professional if there's a need to go on the roof for panel cleaning. Avoid using hard or mineral-rich water. It may damage panels over time.

Does rain clean solar panels?

Rain, in essence, is nature's way of washing and cleaning. It does a decent jobin removing loose dust and light dirt from the solar panels. If your panels are installed at a steeper angle, the rainwater can more efficiently wash away the surface dust. However, the efficiency of rain as a cleaning agent is dependent on the nature of
