1.4 The development of solar energy in The Gambia
By virtue of its geographical location, The Gambia enjoys very good solar insolation throughout the year with slight seasonal variations. The average daily solar radiation ranges from 4.46.7 - kWh/m² making solar energy the most prominent renewable energy resource of the country.
