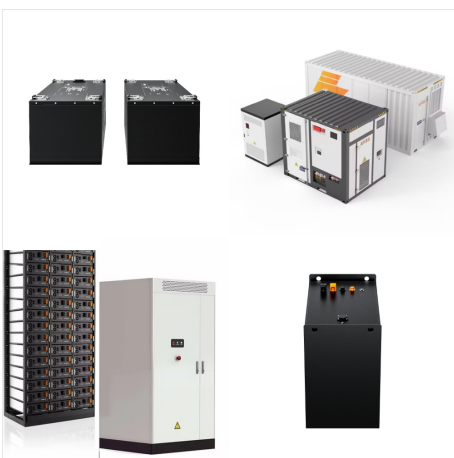



Singapore and the Lao People's Democratic Republic (Lao PDR) have agreed to further support each other's clean energy transition through a memorandum of understanding (MoU) on energy cooperation. The MoU was signed by Second Minister for Trade and Industry Dr Tan See Leng and Lao PDR Minister of Energy and Mines Daovong Phonekeo.



The Singapore Ministry of Trade and Industry (MTI), the Lao PDR Ministry of Energy and Mines (MEM), and the Cambodia Ministry of Mines and Energy (MME) have formed a working group to promote cross-border electricity trade, advancing the ASEAN Power Grid vision.

On the energy front, Singapore has been importing up to 200 megawatts of renewable hydropower from Laos since 2022, under a power integration project that marks the first collaboration among four Asean countries on multilateral cross-border electricity trading.
