Which solar companies offer the best in-house financing?



How Do You Know If a Solar Company is Legit? First, check for a solar company's licensing and insurance. Second, note if there are complaints with the Better Business Bureau or online review sites. Third, see how long they've been in business. A company that has just started out might not be reputable or reliable.


