

Update: With less that two weeks to go before the April 8 total solar eclipse crosses North America, certified solar eclipses glasses are beginning to sell out. But it's not too late! Many vendors on the AAS' list of approved solar eclipse glasses vendors still have glasses in stock, with guaranteed shipping before the big event.

Are eclipse glasses legit?

Companies that sell legitimate eclipse glasses will do this and then earn the right to state the certification--which should be printed on the glasses themselves. "These glasses are mass-produced, so you want to make sure when you get these, you check for imperfections," Youssefzadeh says.

Are eclipse glasses fake?

There are plenty of eclipse glasses available for free or sale in person and online, but experts are urging people to source glasses carefully and beware of fakes. Rick Fienberg, project manager of the AAS Solar Eclipse Task Force, says counterfeiteclipse glasses began appearing on the market just before the 2017 solar eclipse.

Where can I buy fake solar-viewing glasses?

Ebay, Amazon, and other major retailers often see an uptick in counterfeit solar-viewing glasses from third-party sellers in the days leading up to an eclipse. You can find a list of reputable manufacturers at the American Astronomical Society's website.

Are eclipse glasses counterfeit?

While you can pick up eclipse glasses in any number of places right now, the American Astronomical Society (or AAS) recently pointed out that several options on the market are counterfeitand thus unsafe. Rick Fienberg, the project manager of the AAS Solar Eclipse Task Force and a veteran of 14 total solar eclipses, offered some caution.

When should you buy certified solar eclipse glasses?

With less than two weeks before the April 8total solar eclipse in North America, it's time to get your certified

How to Shop for Eclipse Glasses You will see the ISO 12312-2:2015 certification printed on the glasses. This standard ensures that the glasses are safe for solar viewing. It must be printed on the glasses, but remember: Anyone can print anything on the eclipse glasses! Your eclipse glasses MUST have the name of the manufacturer printed on them!

As an additional safeguard, you should visit the legitimate company's website to compare the eclipse glasses they show on the website with the glasses you have. This will help you spot a fake. As you can see below, a real pair from a company called American Paper Optics and a fake pair both look remarkably similar.
