It begins with the sun, known as Sol to the ancient Romans, and extends past the four inner planets through the Asteroid Belt to the four gas giants, on to the disk-shaped Kuiper Belt, and far beyond to the teardrop-shaped heliopause.

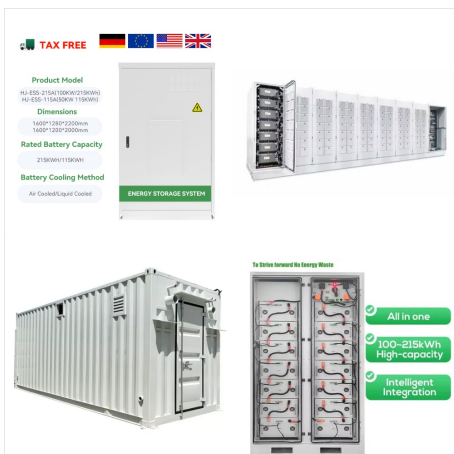
