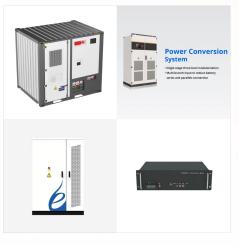


Liberia President Joseph Baokai along with his officials of government officially broke ground to begin the installation of Liberia's first solar farm in Harrisburg, Montserrado County. The project which worth \$90 million is funded by the World Bank, and it is expected to generate 20 megawatts (MW) of electricity by its completion in August 2025.



The cost of solar panels ranges anywhere from \$8,500 to \$30,500, with the average 6kW solar system falling around \$12,700. It's important to note that these prices are before incentives and tax

Liberia then plans to add another 70MW of power through solar PV, which can be accelerated with private sector investment. In July 2024, a memorandum of understanding (MoU) for a World Bank-funded \$16 million regional intervention project was reportedly signed for the construction of the Regional Emergency Solar Power Intervention Project (RESPITE).
