What is Aggreko Power?

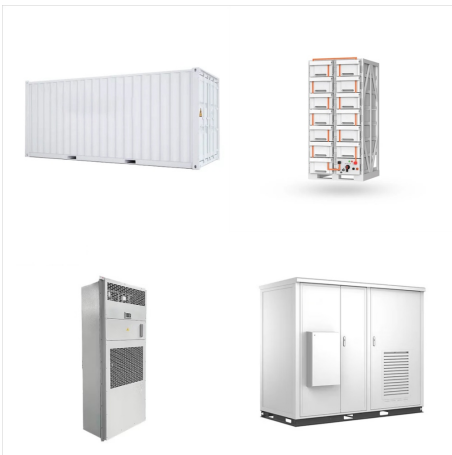
