Conceived and recorded between Martha's Vineyard, New York and New Zealand, "Solar Power" was written and produced by Lorde, along with her frequent collaborator Jack Antonoff, and features backing vocals from the singers Phoebe Bridgers and Clairo. Is solar power a good song?

The song is peppy if familiar, a hodgepodge of the start-stop acoustic guitar rhythm of George Michael's "Faith" and the psychedelic dance-rock of early-'90s U.K. rave kings like Happy Mondays and Primal Scream. It has a good heart and good taste, "Solar Power."

Scream in my life. I'd been told to check them out,"  
Lorde said, adding that when she wrote the tune on  
the piano, she realized it sounded similar to the  
English band's track.

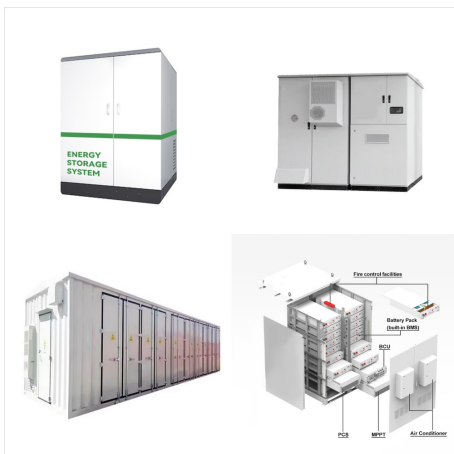
