

What is M-kopa Solar?

In just under three years M-KOPA Solar has provided affordable energy to over 200,000 homes in Kenya, Tanzania and Uganda. They have been so successful that in some cases those who were previously off grid have been supplying power to people on the main electrical grid during the frequent power outages.

Can M-kopa Solar become a \$1 billion company?

M-Kopa Solar plans to become a \$1 billion company by selling solar panels to rural residents and providing them with credit. Tom Opiyo is the best-performing salesperson at M-Kopa Solar, a Kenyan company.

Is M-Kopa a construction company?

Since its commercial launch in October 2012, M-Kopa's Nairobi headquarters has been an active construction site due to its growth.

How does an M-Kopa battery work?

An M-Kopa battery works by receiving a signal from the control box, which is activated when a payment has been made via mobile phone. The control box contains the battery and a SIM card that can communicate with M-Kopa headquarters in Nairobi.

Who owns M-Kopa?

The company is led by co-founder and CEO Jesse Moore. M-KOPA is known chiefly for its pay-as-you-go (PAYG) financing model that allows customers to build ownership of appliances over time by paying an initial deposit followed by flexible micro-payments.

How many employees does M-Kopa have?

M-Kopa directly employs about 700 people in the three countries in which it operates, along with about 1,500 sales agents such as Opiyo working on commission. It's been adding about 50 workers a month. Featured in Bloomberg Businessweek, Dec. 7, 2015.



M-KOPA's Growth Trajectory. As of March 2022, M-KOPA boasts a customer base of 2 million across four African markets. Bolstered by recent funding, the company is poised to emerge as a dominant player in the solar power landscape, potentially attaining unicorn status.



By 2015, M-Kopa had already made a significant impact. It had empowered over 150,000 households in Kenya, Uganda, and Tanzania, enabling them to access affordable and reliable solar power solutions. Users were making approximately 10,000 mobile payments daily through M-Kopanet, the company's cloud platform.



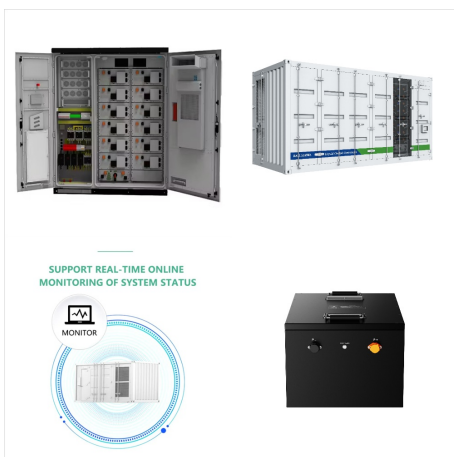
M-kopa was established in 2010 as a lending business model that combined the power of digital micropayments with IoT (Internet-of-Things) connectivity to make financing of solar services and other household products more accessible. M-kopa is a connected asset financing platform that offers millions of under-banked customers" access to life



But companies such as SafeBoda, Asaak and Tugende (similar model to M-KOPA save for the solar systems) are very active in niche cases, providing smartphone and motorcycle financing for riders.
