

Should you switch to solar power in Maine?

In fact, Maine's average of 100 sunny days annually helps many of its solar-generating households save thousands on energy expenses each year. If you're a Mainer considering a switch to solar power, you can take advantage of a number of tax credits, rebates and other incentives offered by the state of Maine and the federal government.

Does Maine have a solar tax credit?

The single biggest solar incentive in Maine is actually a federal tax credit. The Residential Clean Energy Credit, formerly known as the federal investment tax credit (ITC), or simply the federal solar tax credit, can reduce your solar panel system's cost by 30%.

What is Maine's New solar energy program?

The award, to be administered through the Maine Governor's Energy Office (GEO), will create a new statewide program to enable low-income households and communities in the state to access rooftop and community solar and energy storage, while creating job and economic development opportunities in the growing clean energy industry.

Does Maine have a solar rebate?

While Maine does not have a dedicated state rebate for solar panel installation, some manufacturers like LG offer their own solar rebates. These programs are usually time sensitive. For example, LG offers a \$600 solar rebate on their equipment, which your installer can help you redeem over the next year.

Do solar panels increase property value in Maine?

Upgrading your home with solar panels may increase its value. Increased property value typically comes with higher property taxes, but Maine will waive any such increases that result from installing solar energy equipment. Residents must apply in advance for the state's approval to qualify for the exemption.

Do Maine Solar Incentives Make It Affordable for Homeowners to Go Solar? Yes, absolutely. In Maine, the incentives available can reduce your overall solar project costs while maximizing your savings over time. The average cost to install a solar energy system in Maine is around \$21,840 before any incentives, which is about \$8,000 under the national average.



Up from 62 megawatts in 2019, Maine now has 977 megawatts of solar energy installed, with more in the pipeline, though some of those projects may not ultimately come to fruition given challenges with connecting to the grid. 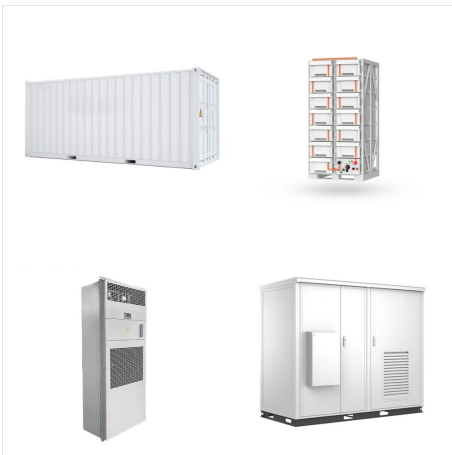

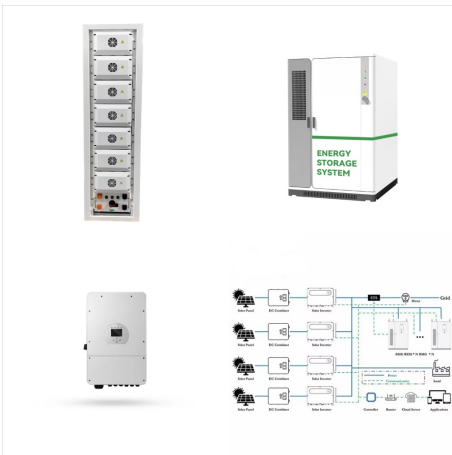
