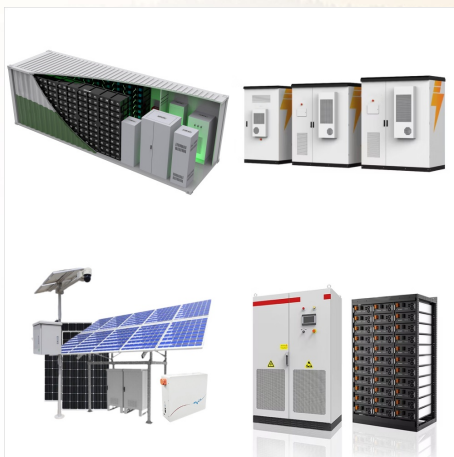

x Heucherella "Solar Power" (PBR) is a striking garden plant characterized by its vibrant foliage. The leaves of "Solar Power" exhibit a unique blend of colors, ranging from a yellowish-green to gold, often with veins or centers of a contrasting deep red to burgundy. This gives the leaves an almost mesmerizing, multicolored effect.



xHeucherella "Solar Power" is a broadleaf evergreen perennial groundcover with gold and burgundy foliage and white flowers in spring. It can grow 16 IN - 20 IN - wide 12 IN tall. Attractive to bees. To grow well it prefers sun - mostly shade and even moisture water. Grows best in well-drained and rich soil. In need of something heat tolerant?



"Solar Power" is a mounding variety that features lobed, yellow-gold to lime-green leaves splashed with red along the veins. It forms a mound of basal foliage to 12" tall spreading to 20" wide. Tiny white flowers on stems rising above the foliage to 16" tall bloom in mid to late spring.



Heucherella "Solar Power" has striking chocolate-brown leaves with a lime-green margin. Plants form a compact dome, and make excellent ground cover. "Solar Power" also works well in container displays ??? either on its own or with other heucheras and heucherellas.



x Heucherella "Solar Power" is a broadleaf evergreen perennial groundcover with burgundy and gold foliage. In spring white flowers emerge. Attracts bees making it an excellent addition to pollinator gardens. Grows well with sun - mostly shade and even moisture water. Does well in rich and well-drained soil.

Foamy Bells "Solar Power" x Heucherella is a cross between Heuchera and Tiarella, and shows some characteristics of both parents. It is an evergreen perennial grown primarily for their attractive evergreen foliage but they do produce flowers too.
