



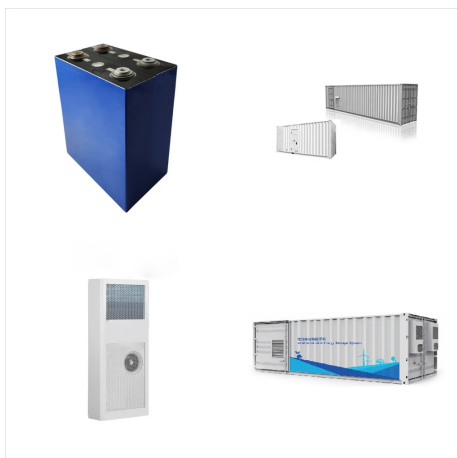
The night sky tonight looks different depending on the location. The constellation maps below show the sky at around 10 pm in the mid-northern, equatorial, and mid-southern latitudes. Northern hemisphere. For northern observers, the sky overhead is dominated by three bright asterisms.

The planet Venus has returned to the early morning sky and has established itself as a dazzling morning lantern, emerging into view from beyond the east-southeast horizon before 5 a.m. local

Catching all seven planets in the morning sky happens relatively infrequently, and the last time such a lineup occurred was in 2004. Plus, you won't get a similar view again until 2041.



In fact, Venus has erupted into view in the eastern morning sky during the past couple of weeks. When September opened, this resplendent "Morning Star" was rising just prior to dawn's first glow

The more in the sky, the better. Less than two months after early risers were able to see four planets in alignment in the morning sky, Mercury will join the party, allowing the U.S. to witness



USA TODAY. Five of the planets in our solar system will appear in a line across the early morning skies until the end of June, astronomers say, in a spectacle that won't be seen again for nearly
