The church said the roof had lasted many years just fine, so no tiles should be removed or holes made to

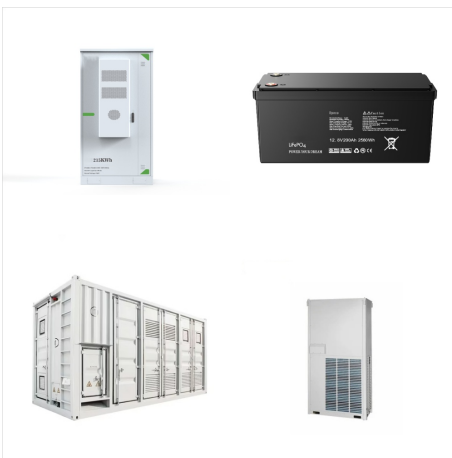

These are what came with the mount brackets for my solar panels and how I attached my panels 2 years ago and have not had any issues with the panels coming loose or with leaking. While it is understandable the concern people have with using screws in the roof, if done properly there should be no leaks.



This can be easily corrected by mounting solar panels on a flat roof at an angle to allow rain or other liquids to flow off. which uses gravity to rest on top of your roof without drilling holes. To maximize the electricity produced by solar panels on flat ???
