

Mozambique's Ministry of Mineral Resources and Energy (MIREME) has announced the launch of a new tender for decentralized solar photovoltaic (PV) and battery energy storage systems (BESS) projects. Funded by a grant from the German Government through the KfW Development Bank, the initiative is part of the GET FiT Mozambique program ???



This past November, Mozambique received around \$26.7m in funding to promote private solar projects and the construction of solar PV systems under the GET FiT (Global Energy Transition Feed-in-Tariff) programme. In total, 25MW of power are to be installed in Mozambique through the solar projects.



Mozambique expects to generate a total of 18,496,557 MWh in 2024, down 1% on 2023, mainly from hydroelectric power plants, seen falling 2% to 14,995,899 MWh ??? essentially from the Cahora Bassa hydroelectric plant run by the state-controlled company HCB, with 14,506,036 MWh (down 3%), but still accounting for 82% of the entire national generating ???
