In a sole proprietorship business, a solitary owner shoulders the responsibility of management, brings in all profits, accepts financial losses, and fulfills tax obligations personally. Generally, sole proprietors operate under their own names, as there's no obligatory requirement to establish distinct business names or trade identities.





Many sole proprietors choose a company name other than their legal name. If you do, you"ll need to file a "doing business as" (DBA) with the county where the principal place of business is located. For example, if your name is John Smith and you choose to name your business "Bob Jones Trucking Company," be sure to file the proper forms.




