

Does NV Energy offer solar energy credits?

In Nevada, the vast majority of people use the utility company NV Energy for electricity. Per regulations, NV Energy must offer a nearly straight exchange of solar power for credits within the same billing cycle. Unused credits can roll over to the following month for 75% of the retail rate.

What happens after NV Energy installs a solar system?

Upon completion of the installation of your system, NV Energy will review your application and may conduct an inspection. The solar electric, wind, hydro and solar thermal incentive programs are governed by state laws in the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS).

How did Nevada's Solar policy change affect new solar installations?

Because the policy change was applied retroactively, it triggered enormous public outcry, and the steep new fees effectively put a freezeon new rooftop solar installations. Nevada saw a 32 percent decline in solar jobs last year after large residential installers chose to pull out of the state.

In Nevada, 93% of residents receive electricity from NV Energy, an investor-owned electric utility company. NV Energy is required by legislation to offer nearly 1-to-1 net metering for excess production in the same monthly billing cycle. This means the credit NV Energy offers is almost the same value they would otherwise charge for electricity.







Net metering allows customers to use energy generated by their leased or purchased solar system to offset their monthly power bill. If a customer's solar system produces more energy in a billing period than used, the excess energy will be pushed back onto the grid and used by other electricity customers.



Solar helps power Nevada in a big way. In contrast to many other states where solar power is responsible for less than 10% of statewide energy production, more than 20% of energy in Nevada comes

Through the end of October, eligible NV Energy customers can apply for the company's Expanded Solar Access Program, called ESAP. The program makes tapping into solar energy a possibility at no added cost, with no solar panels required. Low-income eligible customers are guaranteed a lower rate for energy than the standard rate.





That credit provides up to 30% of the costs to install solar panels or home energy storage back on your taxes next year. NV Energy previously offered a solar battery incentive program that reduced the cost of installing a Tesla Powerwall, Panasonic Evervolt, or other energy storage systems. The incentive expired in 2023.
