

How much does a 5000 watt solar system cost?

A fully installed solar system typically costs \$3 to \$5 per watt before incentives like the 30% tax credit are applied. Using this measurement, 5,000 Watt solar system (5 kW) would have a gross cost between \$15,000 and \$25,000. 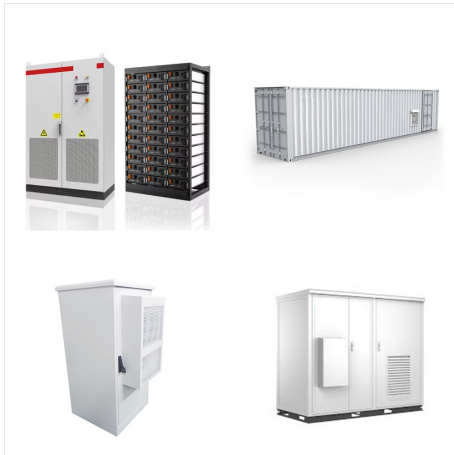

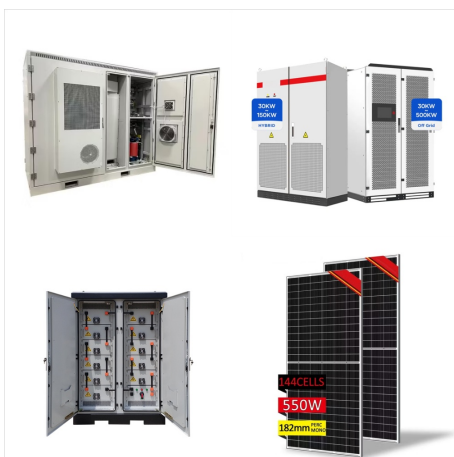

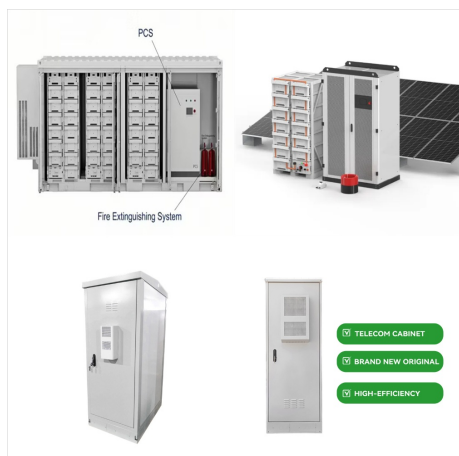

These benchmarks are bottom-up cost estimates of all aspects of PV and energy storage system installations. Note that the prices mentioned above are for bare modules, another way of looking at module prices is to include installation costs. In the US, according to the Solar Energy Industries Association, the price of installed rooftop PV modules for homeowners fell from \$9.00/W in 2006 to \$5.46/W in 2011.
