Is Lorde sharper than he is in solar power?

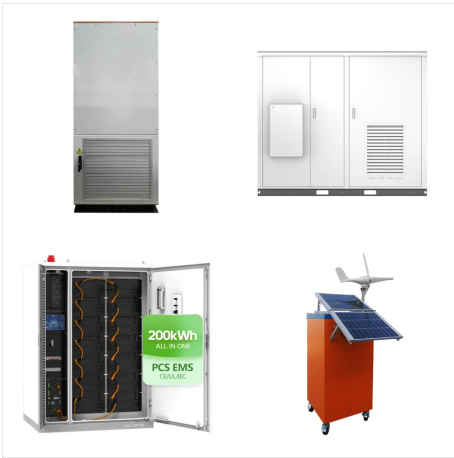
