

How many planets start with E?

There are currently 5 planets that start with E approved by the International Astronomical Union. One of them is Earth (our planet), and the other 4 are exoplanets located outside the Solar system. Unlike stars and constellations whose names come mostly from Greek mythology or Arabic words, planets get their names from many different cultures.

How many planets are named each year?

An average of 492 new planets' names are being added every year (or 1.35 namings per day). In March 1979, only 1924 minor planets had gotten a name and completed the designation process. As of 28 February 2022, the list has 23,081 objects that have been named.

When was the last time the minor planets were last updated?

This is an alphabetical listing of the names of the numbered minor planets. It now lists plain ASCII and accented versions of the names. It was last updated on 2022 Mar. 21.

Do all discovered planets get a proper name?

Not every discovered planet receives a proper name. Most of them only get a scientific designation, but every few years the IAU opens up an international contest where people can submit suggestions to name a few. These are then voted by a committee that includes the person that discovered them.

What planetary bodies are named by WGPSN?

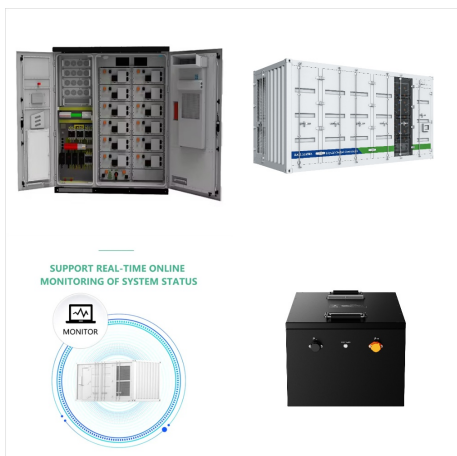

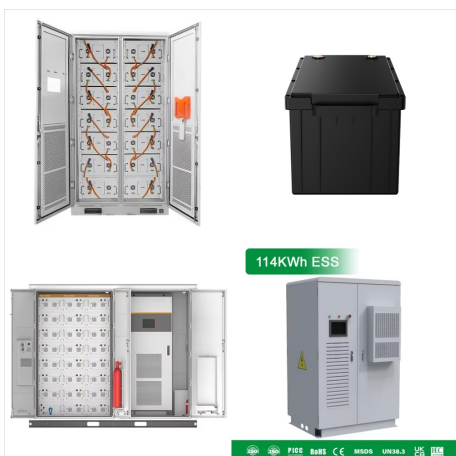
