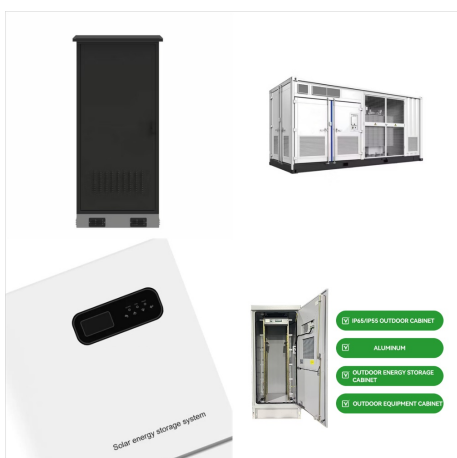
Dominica has chosen to collaborate with Ormat Technologies Inc., a leading geothermal company with over 50 years of experience. Notably, the company manufactures much of its equipment, currently owning or installing approximately 3,200 MW of gross capacity globally. Ormat also operates a geothermal power plant in the nearby island of Guadeloupe.



Looking ahead, Ormat plans to expand its Bouillante power plant and, with the development in Dominica, will bring total generating capacity in the Caribbean to approximately 35 MW. The company also aims to extend its proprietary technology to neighboring islands, displacing fossil fuels in the region's electricity generation.



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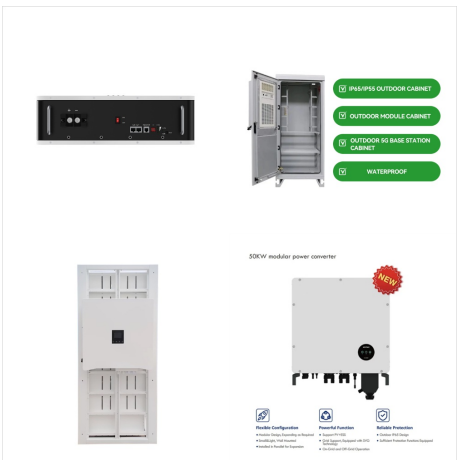
The company is embarking on a groundbreaking initiative to develop a state-of-the-art 10MW binary geothermal power plant in the Caribbean County of Dominica, marking a significant stride towards transitioning the nation away from fossil fuels.



In 2020, the IRC also approved a generation license for a 10 MW geothermal plant for the Dominica Geothermal Development Company (DGDC) of Dominica. In 2022, in compliance with the National Energy Policy, the IRC awarded DOMLEC the project to develop a 5 MW Solar Plant at Tarrou.
