



What does Portugal stand for?

For other uses, see Portugal (disambiguation). Note: Continental Portugal and Madeira use WET/WEST; the Azores are 1 hour behind. Portugal, officially the Portuguese Republic, is a country in the Iberian Peninsula in Southwestern Europe.

Where is Portugal located?

Portugal occupies an area on the Iberian Peninsula (referred to as the continent by most Portuguese) and two archipelagos in the Atlantic Ocean: Madeira and the Azores. It lies between latitudes 30° and 42° N, and longitudes 32° and 6° W.

What is Portugal known for?

Portugal is also known for Azulejo, the art of painted tin-glazed ceramic tilework and Calçada Portuguesa, the characteristic Portuguese paving, used for many pedestrian areas. An independent kingdom since 1143, Portugal established its continental frontiers in 1297 and is one of the oldest nations in Europe.

How old is Portugal?

Portugal's population has been steadily ageing and was the 11th oldest in the world, with a median age of 46 years in 2023. In the same year, it had the world's 4th highest number of citizens over 65 years, at 21.8% of the whole population. [213] [214]

What is the latitude and longitude of Portugal?

It lies between latitudes 30° and 42° N, and longitudes 32° and 6° W. Continental Portugal is split by its main river, the Tagus, that flows from Spain and discharges in the Tagus Estuary at Lisbon, before escaping into the Atlantic.

What is a local administrative unit in Portugal?

Operationally, the municipality and civil parish, along with the national government, are the only legally local administrative units identified by the government of Portugal (for example, cities, towns or villages have no standing in law, although may be used as catchment for the defining services).

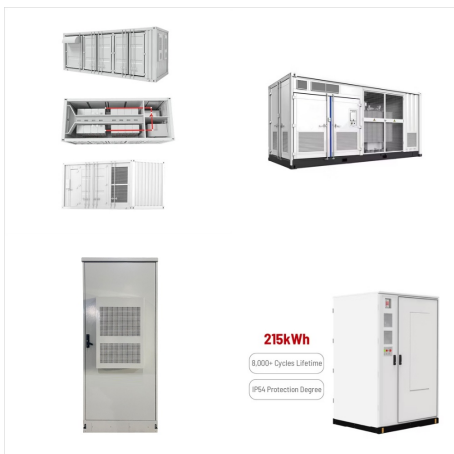
