

The Home Depot has partnered with Call2Recycle, a nonprofit battery recycling program. Rechargeable batteries can be dropped off in Call2Recycle bins at the store. Any rechargeable battery that weighs up to 11 pounds and is under 300 watt hours is accepted.




To find your nearest battery recycling location, jump to the recycling locator or use our recycling search tool. Paid Recycling Options Rechargeable household batteries such as AAA, AA, 9-Volt, D, and C can usually be recycled at Batteries+ Bulbs stores.



The most common places to recycle power tool batteries include local recycling centers, specific chain stores, and recycling programs like Call2Recycle. Always ensure the place you choose accepts the battery type you have.
