



The Premier of the Republic of China, officially the President of the Executive Yuan (Chinese: 行政院長), is the head of government of Taiwan and leader of the Executive Yuan. The premier is nominally the principal advisor to the president and positioned as the head of central government, appointed by the president [2] without approval by the Legislative Yuan. [3]



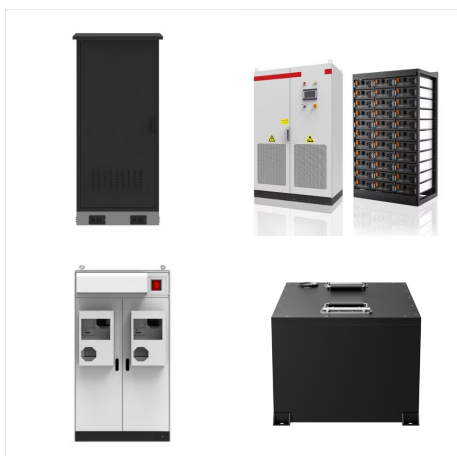
Taiwan Premier Cho Jung-tai told opposition lawmakers Friday that the last two nuclear reactors operated by state-owned Taiwan Power Co. will be retired after 40 years of service on schedule in July 2024 and May 2025, respectively.



Taiwan, officially the Republic of China (ROC), is governed in a framework of a representative democratic republic under a five-power system first envisioned by Sun Yat-sen in 1906, whereby under the constitutional amendments, the President is head of state and the Premier is head of government, and of a multi-party system.
