Is solar power a bright future for Western Washington?

Though we see plenty of rain and clouds here in Western Washington, solar power promises a bright future for our region. In the past few years, more than 5,500 Puget Sound Energy customers have installed their own solar-energy systems. And the number of people going solar continues to grow.

Can PSE guarantee the availability of the Washington Production Incentive Program funds?

Please be aware that PSE cannot guarantee the availability of the Washington Production Incentive Program funds. Eligibility in the state incentive program is determined by the WSU Energy Program.

How much is the AMI for the Puget Sound area?

The law requires the Department of Energy to provide guidance to states and then each can set up its own program. Some states might add energy efficiency or other standards; some might reimburse contractors vs. operating rebate banks. According to Fannie Mae, the AMI for the Puget Sound area for 2022 is \$124,600.

Are electric home rebates tax deductible?

Starting in 2023, there are also federal rebates available from the new "High-Efficiency Electric Home Rebate" program. These aren't tax credits; they're point-of-sale rebates that homeowners will receive as discounts as they make approved improvements. These rebates are tied to household income.





Solar Energy Credit. Generate your own solar energy and get paid for what you don't use on site. When you enroll in the Solar Energy Credit program, PSE will pay you for the excess energy you return to the grid in the form of monthly bill credits. 

Here are the tax credits and other incentives we could identify for the Puget Sound area. Check with your utility company and dsireusa for up-to-date info.. Federal tax credit: Uncle Sam will reimburse you 30 percent of what you paid for panels, equipment, storage devices, installation, and permits. Net metering: If your system produces electricity that you don't use, it's pushed ???

On average, 1 kW of solar power in the Puget Sound region can produce about 1,100 kilowatt hours (kWh) annually. Net metering lets you use the energy you generate to offset the cost of energy used from the grid at other times.





Community Solar is a way for PSE electric customers to share the benefits of 100% local solar power. By subscribing to shares of a local solar array of your choice, you can replace some, or all, of your regular electricity use with renewable solar energy and help drive a clean energy supply that wouldn't be possible without support from subscribers.



Use this interactive decision tool to find out.; Your new heat pump water heater should be located in a space with a minimum 750 cubic feet. For example, in a basement with 7-foot ceilings, a water heater would need open floor space of roughly 10.5 by 10.5 feet around the unit.



Rebate application must be submitted within 30 days of installation and include all required supplemental documentation. If instant rebate is provided by contractor, you will not be eligible for an additional rebate. One rebate per qualified single-family residence. Cannot be combined with any other rebates except where noted.
