Why is hydroelectric power important in Eswatini?

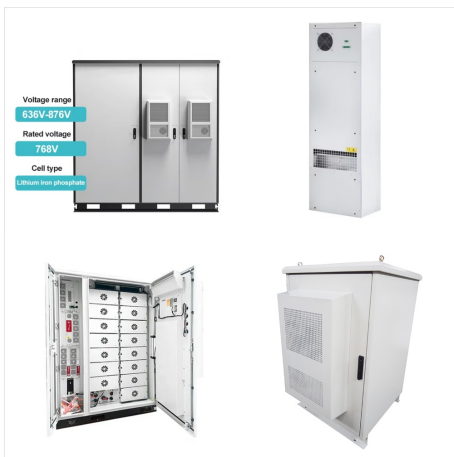
