I am a Regional Manager for a very large Solar Company. I hire people from other Solar Companies often, both large and mom-and-pop size operations. I have never heard of a structure like your client is describing. My average 1st year rep grosses a little over 183K/year. So, their annual take-home pay is not unheard of.

In other words, assuming you have 250 acres of land that is worth 10k per acre - the solar company may say that you have 150 acres of useable land - and offer to lease all 250 acres at a 150 acre rate (they may offer 12% of land value per year - so \$180k/year). I always ask all the interviewers what they like and dislike about the company and their job, what were they expecting and if their expectations were met.

Also I usually check their profiles on LinkedIn beforehand and if they used to work at a company I have an idea about I ask them to compare it to the current company.



If you consider it your duty towards saving the planet, then this a reasonable option. However if the questions are purely financial, let me say that there are many pitfalls. A company hoping you will pay them ?11,000 might "forget" to warn you about them. At the end of thinking about this, only you can make the decision.



As a solar power owner, I have not come across a national solar installation company that consistently provides exceptional customer service across different regions and markets. From my experience and research, locally owned and operated solar companies tend to have better reputations for customer service and overall satisfaction.
