The Wallis Islands are named after the British explorer Samuel Wallis, who sailed past them in 1767, after being the first European to visit Tahiti. The French were the first Europeans to settle in the territory, with the arrival of French missionaries in 1837, who converted the population to Roman Catholicism.

Education System in Wallis and Futuna Islands: Primary Education. There are barely 16,000 people living on these tiny Pacific Islands, and education is hardly a sophisticated affair, although it is compulsory for children aged between 6 and 16. The main education medium in village schools is French. Primary school lasts for 5 years.



The main volcanic islands are Uvea (Wallis) and Futuna and Alofi (Hoorn); the capital and chief town is Mata-Utu, on Uvea. In 1991, BNP Nouvelle-Cal?(C)donie, a subsidiary of BNP Paribas, established a subsidiary, Banque de Wallis-et-Futuna, in the territory.
