Visit [www.call2recycle.com](#) or call 1-800-CLEANUP to learn about local battery recycling opportunities. All you need is your zip code. Often called 'flashlight batteries,' alkaline batteries are usually single use batteries in 9 volt, C, D, AA and AAA. Some alkaline batteries are rechargeable.

Where can I recycle SSLA batteries?

Uses: smaller equipment and backup power supplies. Rechargeable Battery Recycling Corporation (RBRC), which provides the required recycling for most battery manufacturers, accepts SSLA batteries weighing up to 11 pounds. Uses: autos, boats, trucks. Retailers are required to take back for recycling as trade-ins for new batteries.

Can you recycle old batteries?

Retailers are required to take back for recycling as trade-ins for new batteries. Uses: any brand of portable, cordless power tool. Cell phones should also be recycled.


Are batteries recyclable?

Batteries, rechargeable: Batteries found in cordless items such as laptops, power tools, toys, cameras, radios, and phones are not accepted recyclables. Rechargeable batteries include: nickel cadmium (Ni-Cd), nickel metal hydride (NiMH), lithium ion (Li-ion) and small sealed lead (Pb).

Are AA batteries recyclable?

Aseptic containers: Polycoated drink boxes, juice cartons and milk cartons are accepted recyclables and included in Recycle Right - the Simple 5 list. Batteries, alkaline: Alkaline single-use household batteries -AA, AAA, C, D, 6V, 9V are not accepted recyclables. It is safe to dispose of alkaline batteries in your household trash.





During the recycling process for lead-acid batteries, they are crushed. When lithium batteries are crushed in the same container, they explode. Lithium batteries need to be recycled and cannot go into the trash. It is also important to point out that placing Lithium batteries into regular recycling can cause fires at recycling facilities

We accept all types of household batteries at county drop-off facilities. Household and vehicle batteries are also collected at county household hazardous waste events. NOTE: As of January 1, 2024, batteries may no longer be thrown in the garbage in areas served by Seattle Public Utilities. Please follow the guidance on this page and take any batteries for disposal to a hazardous waste collection facility, arrange for a special item pick-up through Seattle Public Utilities, or work with a local battery recycling organization.



Any rechargeable battery that weighs up to 11 pounds and is under 300 watt hours; Auto/tractor batteries including rechargeable NiCad, rechargeable nickel, metal hydride, rechargeable lithium-ion, lithium single-use button, rechargeable small/sealed lead acid batteries; Non-leaking batteries can be dropped off in Call2Recycle bins at the store.



If a lithium-ion battery becomes damaged, contact the battery or device manufacturer for specific handling information. EPA recommendation: Look for labels identifying battery chemistry. Do not put rechargeable batteries in the trash or municipal recycling bins. Find a recycling location near you: Ni-Cd; Li-ion; Ni-MH; Ni-Zn; Pb; Lithium-Ion

These batteries include lithium ion and lead batteries. Failure to follow these laws results in a fine. Call the household hazardous waste collection program if your battery contains hazardous material. Batteries such as lithium single-use batteries and lithium-ion batteries can cause fires.

How to Recycle Right. The first rule in managing batteries safely is to always follow the manufacturer's instructions. Here are additional tips on preparing batteries for recycling. Collect and sort your batteries by type (e.g., lithium-ion, alkaline). Put on latex gloves to avoid any possible contact with powder or acid that can burn your skin.



You can recycle many types of household batteries at B-cycle drop-off locations around NSW. Accepted batteries include: standard size handheld batteries including AA, AAA, C, D, 9V, 6V and lantern batteries; button batteries used in hearing aids, remote controls and watches; standard size handheld rechargeable batteries of all chemistry types

Non-rechargeable and alkaline household batteries may be discarded with regular trash. However, it is illegal to put rechargeable batteries in your trash or recycling. This includes batteries from laptops, cell phones, and digital cameras. If you need to get rid of rechargeable batteries, you can: Drop them off at a Special Waste Disposal site
