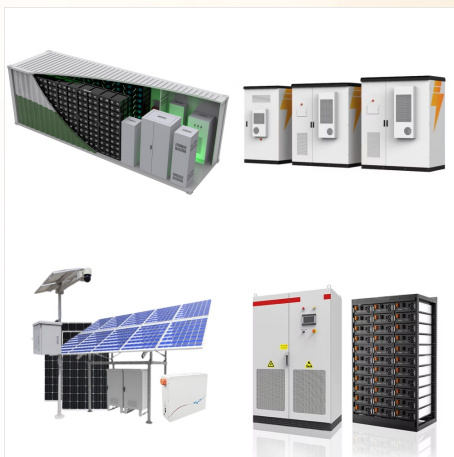
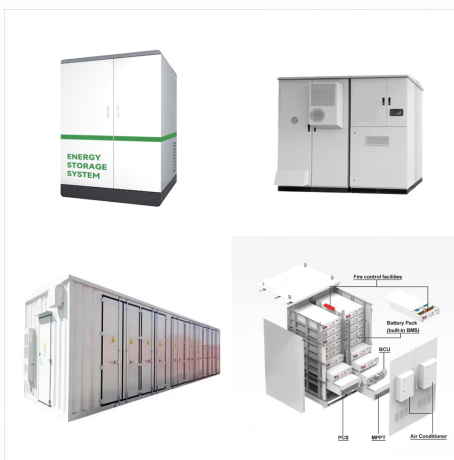




To check for your appointment, click Enrollment dates. To add classes, click on Enrollment: Add Classes. Once you're on the page to search for classes, on the left middle, you'll see some green buttons. One says "Search" and the other says "Schedule Builder" or something along those lines.

Look up the courses you NEED, select a course that works with your schedule, and check against Rate My Professor if that professor is good or not.
