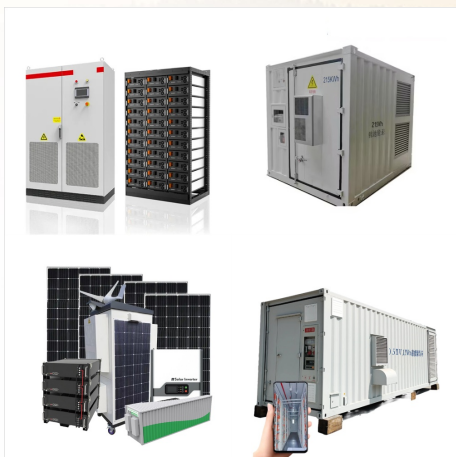

The Master System released in North America in October of 1986 in two iterations: the Sega Base System, which included the system and two control pads for \$150; and the Master System which included the system, two control pads, a Light Phaser, and a pack-in game Hang On/Safari Hunt for \$200. The Base System was dropped sometime around 1987 or '88 after ???

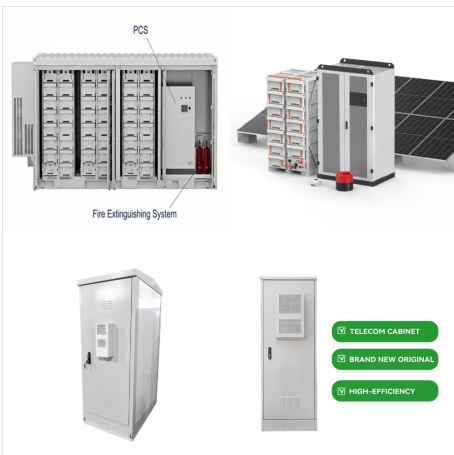

The Sega Power Base converter (Also known as the Master System converter in Europe) was perfect for Sega to add an additional selling point for people looking to make the upgrade to their recently released Genesis / Mega Drive console. The benefit? It enables users to play Sega Master System games on their Sega Genesis / Mega Drive.



1) Make sure the power switch is OFF. 2) Insert the game cartridge in the Power Base (shown below) as described in your SEGA SYSTEM manual. 3) Turn the power switch ON. If nothing appears on the screen, turn the power switch OFF, remove the cartridge, and try again. 4) At the title screen, press Button 1 to start the game.

that the power base doesn't fit, like the Genesis 3 &
Genesis/Sega CD in one unit (i forget what it's
called) As far as incompatibilities there are some,
but it is low actually.



Also, Sega's Power Base Converter, which allows
one to play Sega Master System games on a Mega
Drive, could not be used with the 32X attached. This
is because the Power Base Converter uses a
specific grounding pin to tell the Genesis to enter
Master System mode.

Sega debuted the "Master System" at the Consumer Electronics Show in June of 1986. While the Japanese Mark III was white and looked very much like a rearranged SG-1000 II, the Master System boasted a sleek black-and-red color scheme that distinguished it from Nintendo's neutral (read: boring) gray on the NES. The second cart from Canada is the Power Base FM, also known as Power Base Mini FM is an attempt to enable FM sound for selected Master System games on a Mega Drive without modifying the console. Doesn't really make any sense to get a Japanese Mega Adaptor unless you specifically want to play Mark III and Sega Card games (and don't care about Master System games). The basic (Master System on Mega Drive) functionality can also be achieved by a simple, cheap, no frills pin converter board. Minus the Pause button and Sega Card slot.

The second revision for the PAL model 1, marked on the board as "Power Base VA/PAL" and referred to in Sega service documentation as the "VA1", making it the first SMS board revision to use Sega's "VA" naming scheme. This switched out the V7040 encoder with the Sony CXA1145 and changed the Pause and Reset buttons from metal leaf switches to
