A consortium of Algerian company Cosider and Greybull Capital-owned inverter maker Fimer landed 250 MW of solar. In the undersubscribed 2 GW part of the procurement exercise, a consortium of China International Water & Electric Corp. and China Nuclear Industry Huaxing Construction secured five projects with a total capacity of 780 MW.
