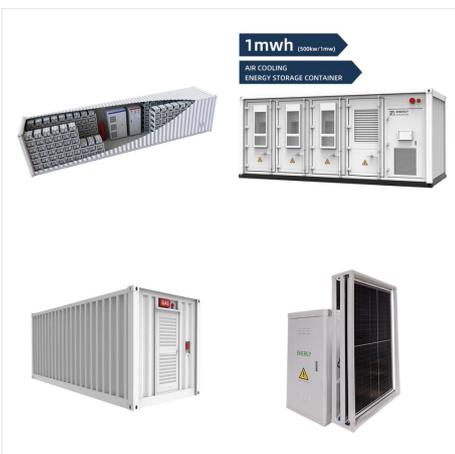

For the solar panel adapter cables, keep in mind that the cable with the red o-ring is the positive. 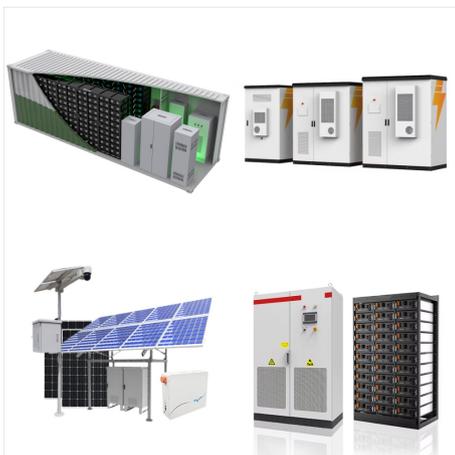
