

NetApp has agreed to acquire the Engenio external storage systems business of LSI for US\$480 million in cash, aiming to serve new applications with growing demands for storage and to get into original-equipment manufacturing (OEM) ???



The business and technology that LSI is selling to NetApp (aka Engenio) is the external storage system business that accounted for about \$705M of their approximate \$900M+ storage business in 2010. This piece of the business represents external (outside of the server) shared RAID storage systems that support Serial Attached SCSI (SAS),
