

Who owns SoCore Energy?

ENGIE North America Inc. announced it will acquire Chicago-based SoCore Energy, a developer, owner, and operator of 150 MW of municipal, co-op, community-based, commercial and industrial solar projects in operation or under construction across the United States, with an additional 170 MW of solar projects in late-stage development.

Does Engie buy SoCore Energy?

Engie acquires SoCore Energy, a Chicago-headquartered solar company and subsidiary of Edison International. The acquisition gives Engie a more concrete corner on the U.S. commercial market.

Does SoCore have battery storage?

SoCore also incorporates battery storage into some of its developments. ENGIE said in a press release SoCore, which will retain its employees and headquarters, will help the company serve utilities, municipalities and corporations that are seeking more renewable energy sources.

United Power announced plans to construct its first commercial scale energy storage project. Located in Firestone, CO and developed in collaboration with Chicago based SoCore Energy, the 4 MW / 16 MWh battery storage system will be the largest facility in the State of Colorado and one of the largest systems owned and operated by an electric co-op anywhere in the country.



Another component of the initiative is the implementation of a battery energy storage system. This system is anticipated to bring numerous benefits, including peak demand shaving, energy arbitrage and demand response capabilities. Oceanside is expected to receive a battery storage system incentive of \$150,000 through the State of California's

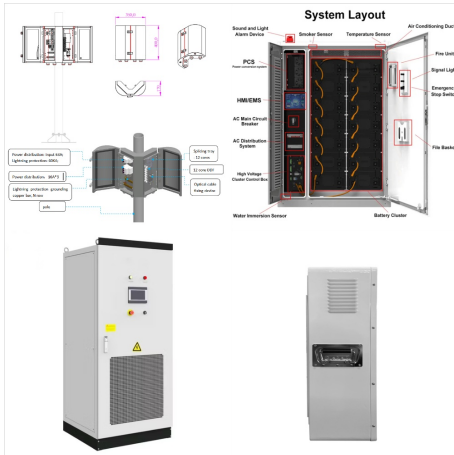
