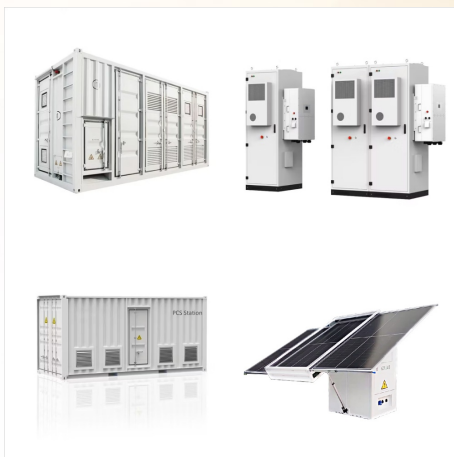

Ireland's national energy-related emissions in 2023 were at their lowest level in over 30 years. Energy-related emissions in 2023 were 31.4 MtCO₂ eq, down 8.3% on 2022 levels, and lower even than those observed during the height of COVID impacts in 2020. Energy-related emissions fell by over 2.8 MtCO₂ eq in 2023 - the largest annual reduction observed in 12 years.

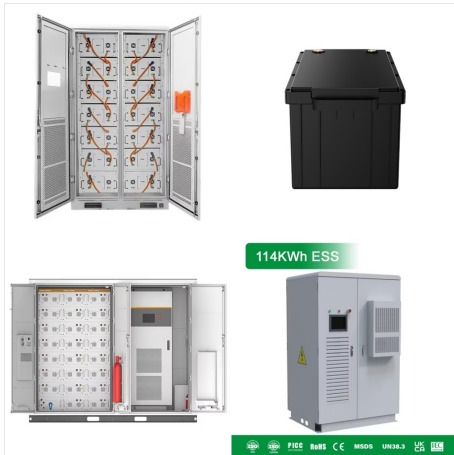
Solar PV also has a role in heat in Ireland, but again this is minimal. SEAI estimates that 14 ktoe of thermal energy from solar thermal panels was produced in Ireland in 2018, all in the residential sector. This made up just 4 per cent of all renewable heat energy. Ambitions to develop the solar energy sector in Ireland predate the new Government.



On average, it takes about 7-10 years for a solar PV system to pay for itself through savings on energy bills. This makes solar energy not only an environmentally friendly choice but also a financially sound investment. Feed ???

Coming online in 2022 Gallanstown Solar Farm in Co. Meath is owned by Octopus Renewables Ltd, a UK investment trust which invests in renewable energy infrastructure. The 198MW solar farm, located outside the town of Ashbourne, first received planning approval in 2018. It was the largest solar farm in Ireland to date, covering an area of 500 acres.



Solar energy in Ireland is provided by both direct sunlight (40%) and indirect sunlight (60%). So, even when the sky is overcast, its radiation (light) is available at ground level and can be converted into useful heat by a solar water heater. ???

According to the Sustainable Energy Authority of Ireland (SEAI) Energy in Ireland 2020 report, renewable energy was supposed to make up 16 per cent of Ireland's energy mix, but it only ended up clocking in at about 13.5 per cent.



"Increasing solar capacity is driven by the Climate Action Plan's target to generate 80% of electricity from wind and solar power by 2030. 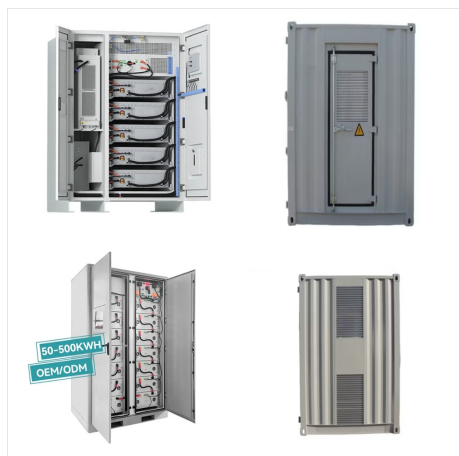
