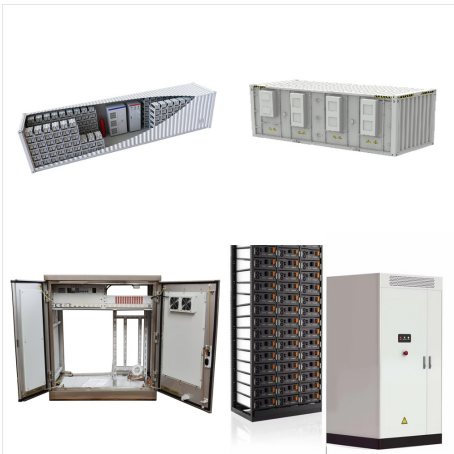

However, some members expressed disappointment with grid electricity due to unreliability (Uganda Bureau of Statistics, 2018). Solar PV uptake on the other hand is growing but the spatial distribution remains asymmetrical. The proportion of households with solar PV has increased tremendously, this may imply growth in demand for solar PVs.
