

Ultimately, the ECCB installed 3,620 solar panels and 20 inverters with a total capacity of 1,200 kilowatts (kW). As of April 2022, the ECCB project was the largest solar generator on the island of St. Kitts and "the largest solar-power system in the Eastern Caribbean operated by any entity other than a power company."



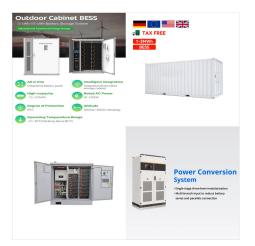
