How much does a 10kW Solar System cost?

Before federal and state incentives, the average 10kW solar system in the U.S. costs about \$30,000. Homebuyers should expect to pay between \$22,000 to over \$35,000 depending on equipment and installation costs. Do solar panels need to be maintained? Surprisingly, very little maintenance goes into owning a solar array.

Ten years ago, a home solar installation cost \$3.60/W according to the National Renewable Energy Laboratory. That's 31% more than what we see on EnergySage right now.

How much does solar panel maintenance cost?

Solar panel maintenance costs: Solar panels have no moving parts, so very little maintenance is required. However, getting routine professional solar panel cleaning and inspections every two years can keep your system in tip-top shape. These solar maintenance costs can be about \$300 per session.

Solar lease or PPA: With a solar lease or PPA, you don"t own your system, so you don"t qualify for some of the best solar incentives.
