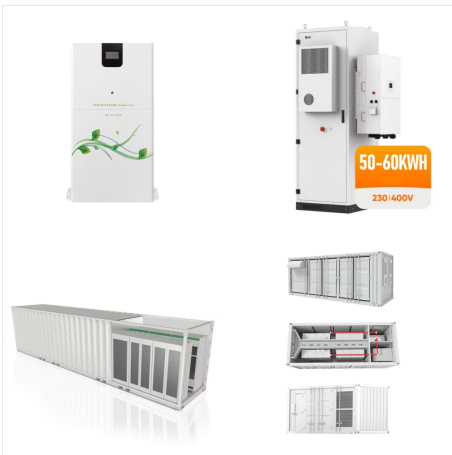

The song was written and produced by Lorde and Jack Antonoff and was released on 11 June 2021 by Universal Music New Zealand as the album's lead single, after being announced on Lorde's website alongside the message "Patience is a virtue". 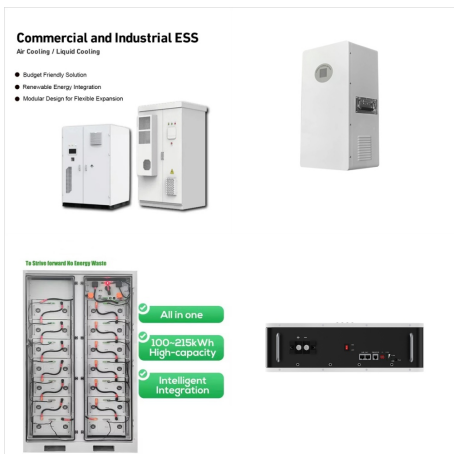
Lorde told Apple Music's Zane Lowe on Primal  
Scream's 1990 dance rock single "Loaded" inspired  
her song, though she hadn't come across it before  
penning "Solar Power." "I had never heard Primal  
Scream in my life. I'd been told to check them out,"  
Lorde said, adding that when she wrote the tune on  
the piano, she realized it sounded similar to the  
English band's track.

The album was preceded by Going South, a June 2021 memoir documenting Lorde's 2019 visit to Antarctica, which she dubbed as the precursor to the album. She stated the title Solar Power was inspired by the trip, and that she "felt like [she] could just chill out and flex a little bit" while creating the record. Three singles were released before the album; the lead single and title track, "Solar

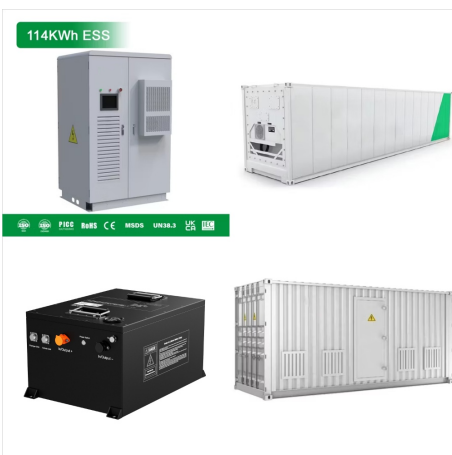
