How do solar panels produce electricity?

Solar panels produce electricity through a process called the photovoltaic effect. Most home solar panels are made of silicon, a semiconductor material. When sunlight hits the silicon in solar panels, the electrons get excited, generating an electric current that goes to a solar inverter and is then used to power appliances and devices.

A solar energy system will likely increase a home's value. A DOE-funded study at the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory found that solar panels are viewed as upgrades, just like a renovated kitchen or a finished basement, and home buyers across the country have been willing to pay a premium of about \$15,000 for a home with an average-sized solar array.



The solar panels that you see on power stations and satellites are also called photovoltaic (PV) panels, or photovoltaic cells, which as the name implies (photo meaning "light" and voltaic meaning "electricity"), convert sunlight directly into electricity. The rated capacity of a solar panel is the power a panel will generate under "standard test conditions". This is a fixed set of conditions used to compare different solar panels, which can be thought of as ideal operating conditions. A typical home solar system might include 19 x 350 W panels, so under standard test conditions the

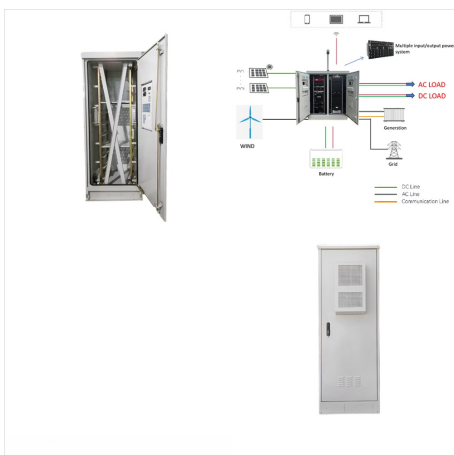
