



How much does home solar cost?

The average pre-incentive cost of home solar is \$29,161 for a three-bedroom house, or \$20,412 after claiming the 30% tax credit. However, as shown in the chart below, the number of bedrooms isn't a great indicator of the size and cost of a solar system - and neither is living space, for that matter.

How much does it cost to install solar panels?

According to our solar experts, solar panels cost about \$19,000 to install in the United States, on average. While the price tag seems steep, incentives and payment options help make the cost of going solar easier to manage. The total cost of a solar installation depends on your location, energy usage, and even the type of equipment you use!

Are solar panels worth it?

Solar panels can generate major savings if you're trying to reduce your electricity costs, carbon emissions or both. The primary factor in determining whether or not solar panels are worthwhile for you is the cost you're currently paying for electricity. The higher your electricity costs, the more a solar panel system will save you in the long run.

Despite their increased initial cost, higher solar panel efficiency can help you save money each month by lowering your utility bill. If you have a larger roof, you may be able to buy more panels with lower production, such as polycrystalline panels, for a decreased cost.

How many solar panels are enough to power a house?

One solar panel is not enough to power a house. Home solar systems typically feature 10-20 panels to produce enough power to offset 100% of the average household electricity consumption.

How much energy does a solar system cost?

Before solar, this represents the average utility rate over the next 20 years, assuming annual rate hikes between 3-5% (based on location). After solar, this is essentially your lifetime energy cost divided by the total production of your system. Here's how that looks for the example system above:  $\$45,102 / 242,483 \text{ kWh} = 18.6 \text{ kWh}$
