Solar Power might well be seen as just that: an album to kick back with on a summer's day. But there is, as Lorde puts it, "deep and shallow" to this record. There are meditations on celebrity culture ("California") and the wellness industry ("Mood Ring"), alongside sorrow for the destruction of the natural world.

And now, after four long years, Lorde is back with the highly antipcated Solar Power. Released on Friday, August 20, 2021 through Universal Music, Lorde's third studio album comes with fourteen songs written/produced all by Lorde her along with Jack Antonoff, who had also worked on Melodrama.



The majority of that criticism comes from two particularly weak points - "Big Star" and "Dominoes" - but even then, both are quite enjoyable as background music or in context of the album. Solar Power is best when it's Lorde-forward, and this occasionally slips.





Lorde offered a full breakdown of her long-awaited new single, "Solar Power," during an interview with Zane Lowe on Apple Music One Friday, June 11th.. The track, Lorde said, was borne during



Lorde told Apple Music's Zane Lowe on Primal Scream's 1990 dance rock single "Loaded" inspired her song, though she hadn"t come across it before penning "Solar Power.""I had never heard Primal Scream in my life. I"d been told to check them out," Lorde said, adding that when she wrote the tune on the piano, she realized it sounded similar to the English band's track.



The album was preceded by Going South, a June 2021 memoir documenting Lorde's 2019 visit to Antarctica, which she dubbed as the precursor to the album. She stated the title Solar Power was inspired by the trip, and that she "felt like [she] could just chill out and flex a little bit" while creating the record. Three singles were released before the album; the lead single and title track, "Solar
