Can solar panels help save money in Mississippi?



As of Nov 2024, the average cost of solar panels in Mississippi is \$2.64 per watt making a typical 6000 watt (6 kW) solar system \$11,084 after claiming the 30% federal solar tax credit now available. This is lower than the average price of residential solar power systems across the United States which is currently \$3.00 per watt .



The Mississippi Public Service Commission approved net metering for solar power users in the state in 2016. Since most homes equipped with solar panels do not have the means to store surplus energy, Entergy Mississippi offers credit to customers who are enrolled in the solar net metering program and can export excess power to the grid.



Mississippi Solar Power Performance Payments (Performance-Based Incentives) Mississippi offers Solar Power Performance Payments, also known as production incentives to customers of the TVA. Solar Power Performance Payments provide small cash payments based on the number of kilowatt-hours (kWh) or BTUs generated by a renewable energy system.





The average price for a home solar panel system in Mississippi is \$15,840 or about \$2.64 per watt. Systems will vary depending on the solar installation company the types of solar panels you choose and the size of your system. However, these rules only apply to specific public utilities like Entergy Mississippi and Mississippi Power, and



Gulfport incentives and rebates. Solar incentives and rebates can cut the cost of installing solar in Gulfport by thousands of dollars.
