



What is solar energy in Poland?

Solar energy in Poland includes the production of solar thermal energy and solar photovoltaics. By the end of 2021, there were around 3,000,000 square metres (32,000,000 sq ft) of installed solar thermal collectors which in Poland are primarily used for heating up household water.

What is the current condition of the photovoltaics sector in Poland?

The following article explains the current condition of the photovoltaics sector both in Poland and worldwide. Recently, a rapid development of solar energy has been observed in Poland and is estimated that the country now has about 700,000 photovoltaics prosumers. In October 2021, the total photovoltaics power in Poland amounted to nearly 5.7 GW.

How much does PV cost in Poland?

According to a report by the Association of the Photovoltaic Industry Poland PV (Association of the Photovoltaic Industry 2020), in 2019, the estimated cost of building 1 kWp of PV micro-systems was PLN 4,125 net, i.e., about 5% less than a year before.

Are solar panels a good idea in Poland?

Solar energy also has high public support in national polls. A survey commissioned by the Polish Photovoltaic Association in 2022 revealed that more than half of the Poles want solar installations in their neighborhoods, while 2 out of 5 respondents think installing solar panels on all buildings is a good idea.

How many PV systems are there in Poland?

As such, the National Renewable Energy Action Plan adopted in 2009 assumed reaching as little as 3 MW of PV energy generation by 2020--a level that has already been exceeded by more than 1,900 times. As of September 30, 2013, Poland had only 14 small PV systems with a total capacity of 1.75 MW (Iglicki et al. 2016a).
