What sharks live in Ireland?

Little gulper shark - (Centrophorus uyato) - 1.0m 40. Angel shark- (Squatina squatina) - 2.1m [formerly also incorrectly referred to as a monkfish, which is an anglerfish (Lophinus Piscatorius)] - critically endangered species with last refuge in Ireland - Tralee Bay, Co. Kerry, Ireland SW. 41. Smooth hammerhead - (Sphyrna zygaena)- 4.0m 42.

Are there angel sharks in Ireland?

Angel sharks were a common sight in Atlantic waters as recently as the 1970s and a regular feature in bays as distant as Norway, Morocco and the Canary Islands. In Ireland angel sharks were plentifuland regularly the subject of angling competitions, particularly on the west coast, but were also regularly seen in the Irish Sea.

Are Hammerhead & Sand tiger sharks coming to Ireland?

Coming to a Beach or Irish Inshore Waters near you !With the arrival of (smooth) hammerhead and small-tooth sand tiger sharks to our shores, it is inevitable that the next species of shark that will be seen in Ireland are Great white sharks and black tip sharks.

Is this the first official record of a shark in Ireland?

Scientists believe this is the first official recordof this rare species in Irish waters. A Swiss tourist emailed shark biologist Nicholas Payne at Trinity College Dublin after he discovered it while walking at Kilmore Quay on Saturday. 
