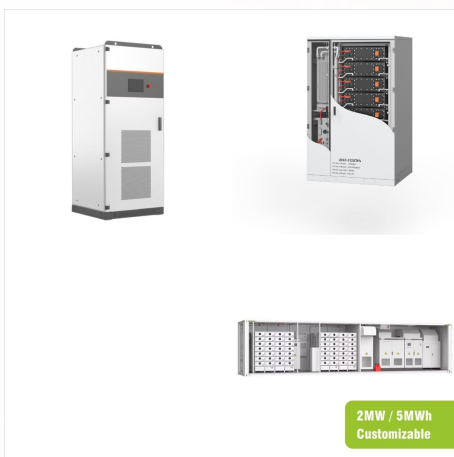




The World Bank and Togo have signed a \$64.2 million financing agreement as part of the Regional Solar Emergency Response Project (RESPITE) to electrify at least 60 localities via renewable electricity. The project includes a 25 MWp solar plant with battery storage and will provide electricity for 12,100 rural households and public lighting.



The Dapaong Solar Power Station is a planned 25 megawatts solar power plant in Togo. In April 2024, the Government of Togo announced an international tender for qualified international firms and consortia to submit bids of expression of interest in the design, procurement and installation of a 25 MW solar power plant, with attached battery



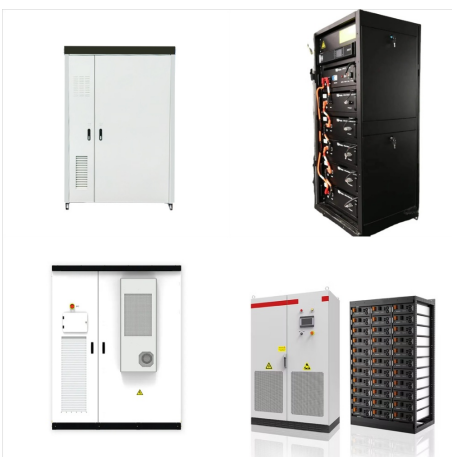
Meridiam has signed a 25-year Concession Agreement with the Republic of Togo and EDF for the design, construction, financing and operation of a 64 MWp photovoltaic solar power plant in Sokodé, in the centre of the country.



After Blitta, a new photovoltaic solar power plant is to be built in Dapaong in the Savanes region of Togo. The project is the subject of an international call for tenders issued by the Respite Project Regional Coordination Unit (URC) based in Monrovia, Liberia.
